SYNOPSIS

BATE FADO, by Jonas&Lander, is a hybrid performance, between dance and a music concert designed for nine performers (dancers, musicians and a fado singer).

Like most of urban musical styles, such as Samba or Flamenco, Fado also had its own dances. In Lisbon, the dance with the most expression was Fado Batido, a dance inspired by an energetic and virtuous tap dance.

In BATE FADO, Jonas&Lander propose to reinterpret and to recover the act of hitting (tapping) Fado, where the quality of a percussion instrument emanates from dance in dialogue with the voice and the guitars. BATE FADO wishes to be the first step to recover the dance that Fado lost.
